


Class Progress

What is the Class Progress Tool?

The Class Progress tool tracks overall student access, behaviour and performance. It provides instructors with a high level view of student performance across the entire class. Four indicators of performance are at the instructor's fingertips, making predictive practices and preventing student disengagement a priority.


Access the Class Progress tool by clicking on **Course Info** in the navbar and selecting **Class Progress** or find it in **Course Admin** under the Learner Management section.

Four Indicators of Progress

Each course can select four indicators of progress for which they can use to monitor how students are performing in their class. These progress indicators can be easily changed or reordered through **Settings on the Class progress page**. Each indicator has a visualisation to highlight overall progress, recent activity, and calls attention to areas of concern, so lecturers can develop plans for getting students back on track.



Indicator	Description
1. System Accesses: 144	System Access (Last 30 days) The System Access indicator displays the number of accesses to the system for the last 30 days.
2. 65% Completed: 55 / 85	Content Completion Summary The Content Completion Summary indicator shows how many required content topics each student has completed.
3. 91%	Quiz Performance Summary The Quiz Performance Summary indicator presents the current average on all quizzes as well as a visualisation of the scores of the last 15 items. Hovering over each bar provides additional details for the quiz.
4. 81%	Grades Performance Summary The Grades Performance Summary indicator presents the current final grade for the student, as well as a visualisation of the scores of the last 15 items. Hovering over each bar provides additional details for the grades.

Indicators

Lecturers can hover over a visualisation to get more details. Clicking an indicator allows lecturers to drill into the details of tool progress for the student in the course. It is also an entry point into the **User Progress** tool where they can look at summaries and details of tools, navigating between students and courses through the left-hand panel, if they have permission. Students will see these same indicators with their own information, whereas lecturers are able to see all the information for each student in the class.

INDICATORS IN DETAIL

Checklist

Displays how far the student has progressed through the checklists in the course. Items due within the next 7 days are highlighted and represents where they should be.

Discussions

Presents the key indicators of engagement for each student across all discussions, including the number of messages the student has read, the number of new posts the student has made, and the number of replies the student has made to other messages.

System Access History

Displays the number of logins to the system each day and summed as a total. Hovering over each bar provides details of each column, including date and number of sessions.

Surveys

Displays how far the student has progressed through the assigned surveys in the course.

Objectives

Illustrates how each student is progressing through the objectives assigned. The focus is on completed activities including both completed objectives and objectives needing remediation.

Content

Displays how far the student has progressed through the content in the course. Items made available to the student to view are highlighted and represent what they should be able to view, based on the desired pace.

Grades

Presents the current final grade as well as a visualisation of the scores of the last 15 items. Hovering over each bar provides details of each column, including grade item name and score.

Assignments

Presents the current average on all assignments as well as a visualisation of the scores of the last 15 items. Hovering over each bar provides details of each column, including the assignment name and score.

Quizzes

Presents the current average on all quizzes as well as a visualisation of the scores of the last 15 items. Hovering over each bar provides details of each column including the quiz name and score.
